1. SPECIFICATIONS:

The following narrative changes are made as indicated.

- a. Clarification: Delete all work associated with West Runway lights and shoulders except for the lights and shoulders associated with Taxiways Bravo, Charlie, Delta and Echo (See drawings 4 through 86). The work for these taxiways shall stop at the point of intersection with the West Runway (See typical detail sheet 1A). All work associated with West Runway marking and signage shall remain in contract.
- b. Revised Page: Section 16526A, page 14, paragraph 2.4.1, the sentence reading "All Taxiway "A" lights south of Taxiway shall be reused." Is changed to read "All Taxiway "A" lights south of Taxiway Delta shall be reused."



may submit a maximum of (5) projects for each of the three areas of concern: concrete airfield paving, operation of a concrete batch plant, and series circuit airfield lighting. These projects shall have been substantially completed TEXT DELETED and demonstrate compliance with the factors below for consideration. Each relevant example submitted for concrete airfield paving must have over 5,000 square yards of airfield concrete pavement of at least 14 inches in thickness and must have been placed using a paving machine. Each relevant example submitted for operating a concrete batch plant must have produced over 500 cubic yards in an eight-hour period. Each relevant example submitted for series circuit airfield lighting must have an installed circuit with lights that is greater than 5,000 linear feet. Failure to provide complete information on at least 3 relevant examples and/or failure to demonstrate compliance with all factors may eliminate the offer from consideration in this solicitation. It is understood that a single project may not address each of the three areas of interest and that accordingly it may be necessary for offers to describe three to five projects for each required area. Offers must provide complete information for each example submitted for consideration as follows:

- Project scope (Total square yards and thickness of pavement)
- Location (city; state)
- Cost (Dollar value of the contract)
- Date of completion, or if substantially complete, state what remains to be done.
- Solicitation number and contract type
- Owner references (names and telephone numbers).

b. Factor 2 - Offeror Past Performance Information: The Offeror will provide a “Past Performance Evaluation Questionnaire” to the point of contact for each of the project examples submitted in item 6.00(a). The project point of contact must complete the questionnaire and mail, fax, or email it directly to Ms. Alice M. Jeffres, Contract Specialist, at Alice.M.Jeffres@nwk02.usace.army.mil no later than the closing date on the RFP. The Offeror is responsible for ensuring that the completed questionnaires are provided by the closing date. The Offeror must receive an overall rating of average or above in response to the questionnaires before his proposal will be considered technically acceptable. An above average rating in one area of the question may offset a below average rating in another. However any response received that is rated as unsuccessful or highly dissatisfied will be considered technically unacceptable. A copy of the questionnaire is included at the end of paragraph 6.00.
